

JERRY SCHUBEL, Ph.D. - LEGACY AWARD

Dr. Jerry R. Schubel has been president and CEO of the Aquarium of the Pacific since 2002. He is president and CEO Emeritus of the New England Aquarium, and from 1974-1994 was Dean of Stony Brook University's Marine Sciences Research Center. For three of those years he served as the University's provost and is Distinguished Service Professor emeritus. Prior to 1974, Dr. Schubel was an adjunct professor, research scientist and associate director of The Johns Hopkins University's Chesapeake Bay Institute. Dr. Schubel holds a Ph.D. in oceanography from Johns Hopkins University. He received an honorary doctorate from the Massachusetts Maritime Academy in 1998.

He has worked throughout his professional life at the interfaces of science-management-policy on issues dealing with the ocean with an emphasis on the coastal ocean. Dr. Schubel has published more than 225 scientific papers and has written extensively for general audiences. He is a member of the California Ocean Science Trust Board, and the Science Advisory Team for California's Ocean Protection Council. He chaired the NOAA Science Advisory Board; National Sea Grant Review Panel; the National Research Council ("NRC") Marine Board; the NRC Committee on the St. Lawrence Seaway, Phase I and Phase II, the Ocean Research and Resources Advisory Panel, and the NRC Committee on the Value and

Sustainability of Biological Field Stations, Marine Laboratories and Nature Reserves in 21st Century. He is a former member of EPA's Science Advisory Board, the Census of Marine Life U.S. National Committee and the National Science Foundation's Education and Human Resources Advisory Committee.

At the Aquarium of the Pacific, he created the Aquatic Forum that brings together scientists, policy-makers and stakeholders to explore alternative ways of dealing with important, complex, and often controversial environmental issues facing the nation. He also directs the Aquarium's Marine Conservation Research Institute and the Aquarium's Aquatic Academy programs. He has been interviewed by hundreds of media outlets on a variety of environmental and scientific topics for international, national and local stories.

Krishnan. Krishnan. Aishu continued her study of Carnatic music under the guidance of Indias famed musicologist Shri S.R. Janakiraman,

While continuing to play South Indian Classical Music, Aishu began training at the Berklee College of Music with an emphasis on jazz performance, earning a full scholarship. She carries the unique distinction of being the youngest student to receive a Bachelors of Arts from this esteemed institution. Aishu continued with her second Bachelors degree at Stanford University in Stanford, California. Her average day begins at 5 AM and includes 5 to 6 hours of practice and a whole day at school. She maintains a rigorous concert schedule, is an exceptionally talented swimmer and a dedicated student with a full academic load. Currently, Aishu is a medical student at Baylor University.

Career highlights include performances in the Historic Hoover Theater in San Jose, and the Women's Music, Art, Dance, and Word Festival. Aishu was also the featured artist during halftime of the Nets/Knicks basketball game at Continental Airlines arena. She has also been featured on NPR's "Crossing East" series, and will be highlighted in HBO's The Music in Me, Senses Magazine, and was the featured artist on Entertainment Studios documentary, The Young Icon. In 2008, Aishu recorded her second album Bliss, and since then, she has performed benefit concerts to raise not only money, but also awareness for this initiative.

Currently, Aishu is in medical school at Baylor. "I can finally see a second avenue to be able to help BIPAI. I look forward to one day having a medical degree in my hand and being on the front lines with Dr. Kline and the team setting up clinics and offering treatment to individuals with HIV/AIDS. Perhaps, I will bring my violin along.But until then, I will be continuing to perform my music and speak to my audiences about HIV/AIDS, BIPAI, and working towards eradication.


